

Leh violence: Inquiry commission to allow 30 days for public submissions after notification

LEH, OCT 28/--/A former Supreme Court Judge, heading a three-member judicial inquiry into Leh violence, said they will allow 30 days for the public to submit evidence and information related to the September 24 incident which left four people dead and scores of others injured.

Justice (retd) B S Chauhan said the notification will be published shortly informing the public about the terms of reference of the inquiry commission.

The commission will later examine the collected material from December 10 onwards and is open to meet anyone coming

forward, Justice Chauhan told reporters here.On October 17, the Centre addressed a key demand of the protesting Ladakh groups by announcing a judicial inquiry into the violent clashes.

According to a notification issued by the Union Home Ministry, the judicial probe is mandated to investigate the circumstances leading to the serious law and order situation, the police action and the resultant unfortunate deaths of four people.Retired district and sessions judge Mohan Singh Parihar will function as judicial secretary, while IAS officer Tushar Anand will be the administrative

secretary of the inquiry commission.

“We will meet anyone who wants to come forward with evidence and information. We will be publishing a notice to allow people to share any evidence or information within 30 days. After that we will sit here from December 10 to examine the collected material and also meet the public,” the retired Supreme Court judge said.On October 24, the Law and Justice Department in an order said the judicial inquiry shall be held at the Alternate Dispute Redressal Centre at Melongthang in Leh from October 25 to 28.The order

also requested interested and aggrieved persons, if any, to record their testimonies before the members of the judicial panel.

“It is a public inquiry which is open to all. In accordance with the formality and procedure, a public notice will be published highlighting the terms of reference and what type of information is required to be submitted. Anyone who wants to share the information should come forward after the publication of the notice,” Justice Chauhan said.He said his team is always available to the public to record their statements or share any relevant

information.

Leh Apex Body (LAB) co-chairman Chering Dorjay said he met Justice Chauhan and was told that a notification will be published soon, seeking information and evidence from the public.“Once the notification is published, the public will be given enough time to submit any information or record their statement. They will welcome all with open hearts,” he said.

He said the commission has declined to take a pendency containing some videos about the violence. “We will submit the evidence after the issuance of the notification within a couple of days.” (PTI)

All drug de-addiction centres functional in J&K: Minister Itoo

SRINAGAR, OCT 28/--/The Jammu and Kashmir government on Tuesday said all drug de-addiction centres were fully functional across the Union territory and concrete steps are being taken to curb the menace.Minister for Health and Medical Education, Sakeena Itoo, made these remarks while replying to a question of legislator Surjeet Singh Salathia in the legislative assembly.

Itoo said all drug de-addiction centres are fully functional in J&K and have also been directed for fee regulation for affordable rehabilitation of victims.The minister highlighted that the health and education departments along with law enforcement agencies are playing an active role to fight the menace of drug abuse in society.

She added that strict instructions have been issued to head of all educational institutions (colleges and schools) to install CCTVs in and around their campuses to check any kind of irregular activities.Itoo also lauded the role of NGOs in dealing with this alarming situation across J&K, saying that their support is must for combating this social evil.(PTI)

J&K recorded over 2 lakh dog bite cases in past three years: Govt

SRINAGAR, OCT 28/--/ Jammu and Kashmir recorded more than two lakh dog bite cases in the past three years, and a comprehensive drive for sterilisation and immunisation of stray dogs has been launched in the Union territory, the J-K government informed the Assembly on Tuesday.

In reply to a question by National Conference (NC) MLA Mubarik Gul, the government said 2,12,968 cases of dog bites have been recorded in the Union territory since 2022.

While 98,470 cases were reported from the Jammu division, 1,14,498 cases were recorded in the Kashmir division, Chief Minister Omar Abdullah, who also holds the housing

and urban development portfolio, said in the written reply in the Assembly. According to the data shared by the government, Jammu district reported the highest number of cases during the period under review at 54,889, followed by Srinagar city with 36,406 cases. Anantnag district in south Kashmir was third with 26,453 cases, followed by Baramulla in north Kashmir at 18,563.

Shopian district in south Kashmir reported the lowest number of dog bite cases -- 1,357 -- in the past three years, the government said.

A comprehensive drive for the sterilisation and immunisation of stray dogs has been launched, it said. From June 2023 to

September 2025, 48,998 stray dogs were sterilised and vaccinated, Abdullah said.The Srinagar Municipal Corporation (SMC) tops the list with 27,237 sterilisations and vaccinations, followed by the Jammu Municipal Corporation (JMC) at 13,730.The municipal committees in the other districts of Jammu region carried out 7,870 sterilisations and vaccinations, the government said. The chief minister said while Srinagar has two Animal Birth Control (ABC) centres and is establishing a third, the Directorate of Urban Local Bodies, Kashmir, is in the process of setting up such centres in the remaining nine districts of the Kashmir Division, for which identification of land has been taken up with the deputy commissioners.

In the first phase, land/building has already been identified for three clusters at Baramulla, Kulgam and Sumbal for establishing these centres, the government said. (PTI)

Govt, opposition spar in J&K Assembly over issue of transfers in education department

SRINAGAR, OCT 28/--/ Ruckus broke out in the Jammu and Kashmir Assembly on Tuesday after BJP MLA from Doda West Shakti Parihar alleged regional discrimination in transfers in the education department.

Parihar claimed while transfers in the education department have been affected in Kashmir, "Jammu has been ignored".

This led to a ruckus between the treasury and opposition benches.

Education Minister Sakina Itoo said the BJP was "habitual of crying discrimination".

"There is no discrimination," she asserted. Referring to the recruitments in the department, the minister said while 350 appointments were made in the Kashmir valley, 860 were made in the Jammu region.

"DPC (departmental promotional committees) is in process and will be done in due course. Transfers were started from Poonch and Rajouri districts, but it has been kept in abeyance due to objections," Itoo added.

The minister said there was a blanket ban on recruitment, and posts were not referred to the recruitment agencies.

She said, "1500 posts were frozen by them. The education department was on the verge of being defunct. I am thankful to chief minister (Omar Abdullah) for de-freezing 50 per cent posts".

"They should tell us where they have brought the education department," Itoo said, pointing to the BJP.


The House then returned to normal business. (PTI)
