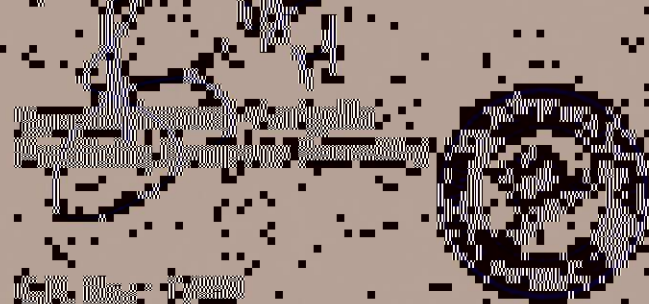

Memorandum Understanding between the Government of India and the Government of Karnataka

The Government of India and the Government of Karnataka, hereinafter referred to as the Parties, have entered into this Memorandum Understanding (MoU) for the purpose of strengthening the cooperation and collaboration between the Government of India and the Government of Karnataka in the field of women's economic empowerment. The Parties have agreed to work together to promote the growth and development of women-owned enterprises and to provide support and assistance to women entrepreneurs. The Parties have also agreed to share information and resources and to conduct joint research and studies on women's economic empowerment. The Parties have further agreed to hold regular meetings and consultations to monitor the progress of the MoU and to address any issues that may arise. The Parties have also agreed to promote the MoU through various media and to encourage other States and Union Territories to enter into similar MoUs with the Government of India.

- 1. The Government of India shall provide technical assistance, training, and capacity building support to women entrepreneurs in Karnataka.
- 2. The Government of Karnataka shall provide financial support and infrastructure facilities to women-owned enterprises in Karnataka.
