Telangana Govt enhances retirement benefits for Anganwadi staff



Hyderabad, May 29 (TSIT) In a significant move, the Telangana government has approved enhanced retirement benefits for Anganwadi teachers and helpers across the state.

The Finance Department

who retire will receive Rs 2 lakh, while helpers will receive Rs 1 lakh as retirement benefits. This is a substantial increase from the existing benefits of Rs 1 lakh for teachers and Rs 50,000 for helpers.

The Finance Department has cleared a proposal from the Women and Child Welfare Department, paving the way for the issuance of a Government Order (GO) to implement the revised benefits.

As per the new provisions, Anganwadi teachers

Fulfilling an electoral promise, the state government—referred to as the “Praja government”—has doubled the retirement benefits, offering greater financial security to thousands of families dependent on these workers.

Although the proposal had been pending due to technical reasons, progress was made after Women and Child Welfare Minister D. Danasari Anasuya Seethakka met with Finance Minister Batti Vikramarka to discuss the matter. Following their discussions, the Finance Department granted the necessary approval.

Hyderabad City Police launches Zonal Cyber Cells to combat cybercrime surge

Hyderabad, May 29 (TSIT) In a landmark initiative to strengthen the city's response to cybercrimes, Hyderabad City Police Commissioner C.V. Anand officially launched 'Zonal Cyber Cells (ZCCs)' across all seven zones of the city, on Thursday. The initiative aims to provide swift, localised, and effective solutions to the escalating threat of cybercrime. Formation and Evolution of Cyber Crime Police Station (CCPS), said Anand, also the DG rank, on the occasion. The launch of the Zonal Cyber Cells comes at a time when cybercrime is at an all-time high.

Over the years, there has been a sharp increase in reported cases, demonstrating both the growing prevalence of cyber offenses and increased public awareness, he said, adding that cybercrime cases have more than doubled from 3,393 (2019) to 2,550 (2020), likely due to increased online activity during the pandemic. Cybercrime cases have surged by 786 percent in the last nine years (2015-2024), the police commissioner said, adding that the cases continue to increase year-on-year.

(2022-2024), showing an urgent need for robust cybercrime prevention measures. The increase also indicates that more victims are coming forward to report incidents, helping law enforcement take action. He said the establishment of Zonal Cyber Cells marks a crucial step in enhancing Hyderabad's cybercrime response mechanism.

With dedicated units in each zone, the police are now better equipped to handle the cybercrime complaints efficiently, improve detection rates, and facilitate the refund process for victims, said Anand. He said that establishment of the ZCCs aims to provide a swift, localised, and effective response to cybercrime complaints such as financial and Social Media Frauds. The key objectives of the ZCCs include: enhancing the investigation and resolution of cybercrime cases with greater efficiency; providing localised, rapid response to cybercrime complaints within each zone; raising public awareness about cyber safety and preventive measures, he informed.

Mayor Gundu Sudharani Suggests Installation of Alternative Valve at Mattewada Water Tank

WARANGAL, May 29 (TSIT BUREAU): City Mayor Gundu Sudharani emphasized the need to install an alternative valve alongside the existing one at the Matwadeva Water Tank, citing frequent disruptions to the water supply at several divisions. During her visit to the site in the 24th Division on Thursday, the Mayor inspected the ongoing valve repair work and reviewed the progress. She noted that repeated outages at this particular valve have been causing shortages in the 18th, 28th, and 29th divisions, leading to inconvenience for residents.

To prevent further problems and ensure uninterrupted water supply, Mayor Sudharani directed the engineering officials to install a protective grill around the valve to enhance safety, especially for children. The inspection was attended by Assistant Engineer Habib Mozamil, School Principal Aruna, and Work Inspector Lingamurthi, among others. The Mayor's intervention is a commendable step for municipal administration to swiftly address critical infrastructure concerns and ensure better services for the citizens of Warangal.

Addressing the media at the party's state office in Nampally on Thursday, Sridhar said both BRS and Congress have failed to uphold the rights and welfare of SC and ST communities, despite relying on their votes to form governments.
