# Students who took Nursing CET can now apply for BSc Nursing

THE STATE Common Entrance Test (CET) Cell has announced a major revision in eligibility criteria for the BSc Nursing course. Under the new rules, all candidates who appeared for the Nursing CET are now eligible to apply for admission, regardless of whether they secured the previously required 50 per cent in the CET. However, candidates are still required to have scored a minimum of 50 per cent in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology (PCB) in their Class 12 exams.

This change in the eligibility criteria comes at a time when nearly four rounds of the Common Admission Process (CAP) have already been completed. To accommodate the newly eligible candidates, the Maharashtra CET Cell has declared a revised schedule for an extended round of admissions. The extended round will also offer opportunities for candidates who were unable to complete the admission process due to heavy rainfall in various parts of the state.

The CET Cell, in an official statement issued on Monday evening, confirmed the reopening of the BSc Nursing application process. "Students who appeared for the MIT-CET for Nursing this year but did not apply for CET admission due to not securing 50 percentile marks, can now register for admission. They should visit the CET Cell's official website [www.mahacet.org](http://www.mahacet.org) and complete the admission registration. Additionally, students whose

registration was previously incomplete should complete their admission registration to be considered for the opportunity for admission," the statement said.

The change in eligibility criteria follows approval from the Indian Nursing Council (INC) after requests from nursing colleges, particularly those in the private sector, to reduce the CET cut-off. According to college authorities, the revision is aimed at addressing the growing issue of vacant seats in nursing colleges, especially those managed privately.

Balasahab Pawar, president of the Private Nursing Schools and Colleges Management Association—Maharashtra state, had earlier written to the CET Cell highlighting that many qualified candidates were missing out on admission due to the high CET percentile requirement. Pawar emphasised that several other states such as Kerala, Bihar, Uttar Pradesh, Telangana, Andhra Pradesh, Gujarat, and West Bengal conduct BSc Nursing admissions primarily based on Class 12 marks, without mandating an entrance test or percentile. In his approach, he said, leads to better seat utilization and greater accessibility for students.

Pawar also pointed out that there are over 200 nursing colleges in Maharashtra offering more than 16,000 seats in the BSc Nursing programme, yet more than 7,500 of these seats remain vacant. He stressed that removing the percentile condition would be a key step in addressing this issue, as well as in strengthening Maharashtra's healthcare workforce by training more nurses.

## Brothers working as drivers take Mumbai police on three-state tour after fleeing with Rs 45 lakh

TWO BROTHERS who work as drivers escaped with a bag containing Rs 45 lakh belonging to a Chartered Accountant on September 19. As the police started chasing them, they fled to Madhya Pradesh, Uttar Pradesh and finally to Bihar. The duo was arrested on Sunday and Rs 36 lakh has been recovered so far.

An official said that on September 19, around 8 pm, the complainant Tej Prakash, a Wadala resident and a CA, kept a bag with Rs 45 in his car, trust-


ing Nitesh Mahto, who had been working as a driver for nearly six months. As per police, he was attending an auction later and hence carrying the cash.

Prakash left to see his granddaughter, when Mahto spoke to his elder brother Deepak who

also works as a driver in the city. Deepak told his younger brother to pick up the bag and escape.

The duo along with another relative took a train to Pune. From Pune, they took another train to Uttar Pradesh. By this time, the complainant had ap-


proached the Govandi police. Eventually, the police team found they were headed to Bihar, from where they hailed. Finally on Saturday, the police team nabbed the brothers from Bihar where they were issued a notice to appear before the police.

**REDRESSAL OF COMPLAINTS AGAINST ENTITIES REGULATED BY RBI**

**Reserve Bank-Integrated Ombudsman Scheme**

Reserve Bank of India (RBI) launched the "Reserve Bank – Integrated Ombudsman Scheme, 2021" (RB-IOS). The Scheme simplifies the grievance redressal process at RBI by enabling the customers of Regulated Entities (REs) like banks, Non-Banking Financial Companies (NBFCs), Payment System Participants (PSPs) and Credit Information Companies to register their complaints at one centralised reference point. The RB-IOS provides cost-free redress of customer complaints involving deficiency in services rendered by the REs of RBI, if not resolved to the satisfaction of the customers or not replied within a period of 30 days by the RE.

The RB-IOS adopts a "One Nation One Ombudsman" approach for all complaints against any RE. It is therefore no longer necessary for a complainant to identify under which Ombudsman scheme/office he/she should file complaint with the Ombudsman.

Complaints received at RBI against the REs not covered under the RB-IOS are redressed at the Consumer Education and Protection Cells (CEPCs) of RBI. Any complaint against an RE can be filed through any of the following modes:

- Online-through the Complaint Management System (CMS) portal of RBI on <https://cms.rbi.org.in> - File a complaint.
- Email-at: [crpc@rbi.org.in](mailto:crpc@rbi.org.in) in the form as specified in Annexure in the RB-IOS, available on the above portal.
- Physical complaint (letter/post) in the form as specified in Annexure in the RB-IOS to "Centralised Receipt and Processing Centre, 4th Floor, Reserve Bank of India, Sector-17, Central Vista, Chandigarh-160017".

**Appeal against decision of RBI-Ombudsman**

Appeal against the decision of RBI-Ombudsman can be filed online on CMS portal at <https://cms.rbi.org.in> - File an Appeal or sent to the Appellate Authority, Reserve Bank of India, Consumer Education and Protection Department, Central Office, 1st Floor, Amar Building, Sir PM Road, Fort, Mumbai 400 001 (E-mail: [aas@rbi.org.in](mailto:aas@rbi.org.in)) within 30 days of receipt of the communication of the RB-IOS Ombudsman's decision, only if the complaint is closed under the appealable Clauses of RB-IOS.

**Important Information**

**Note 1:** Before lodging any complaint under the RB-IOS/ CEPC, the complainant must approach the concerned bank/NBFC/Payment System Participant with the grievance. If the grievance is not redressed within 30 days or if complainant is not satisfied with the reply given by the bank/NBFC/Payment System Participant, he/she can approach the RB-IOS Ombudsman/CEPC. The complainants can approach the RB-IOS Ombudsman anytime within one year of receipt of such reply from the concerned bank/NBFC/system participant. In case no reply is received from the bank/NBFC/Payment System Participant, RB-IOS Ombudsman can be approached anytime within one year and one month from the date of representation to the entity.

**Note 2:** The complainant MUST indicate his/her name, address and present contact number in the written/email complaint.

**Note 3:** The complaint can be lodged by the complainant personally or through an authorized representative, along with an authorization letter other than through an advocate unless the advocate is the aggrieved person.

**MANUFACTURING GETS TOP PRIORITY IN ANJAN VISION DOCUMENT**

The Chief Minister informed the gathering that a comprehensive development roadmap titled "Anjan Vision" has been prepared to align with the national goal of Viksit Bharat @2047.

This document outlines a phased development strategy with manufacturing identified as the core focus area specially steel and power, the backbone industries of Chhattisgarh.

**KEY FEATURES OF THE NEW INDUSTRIAL POLICY**

- The policy includes a range of provisions aimed at achieving the objectives of industrial growth, employment generation, and socio-economic development.
- As part of the new industrial policy, a provision has been made for a training stipend reimbursement of Rs 15,000 per person. This incentive is designed to encourage industries to convert skilled individuals from Chhattisgarh into formal employment.
- By offering this financial support, the policy aims to enhance the employability of the state's youth, ensuring they are better equipped to meet the demands of the industrial sector and contribute to the state's economic growth.
- The government aims to create 5 lakh new formal jobs over the next five years through this policy.

Chhattisgarh's new industrial policy, effective from November 1, 2024, and set to remain in force until March 31, 2030, is a strategic step aimed at accelerating the state's industrial development. Since the state's formation, various industrial policies have been conceptualized and implemented to promote growth, with the latest policy marking the sixth iteration since 2001. These policies have continuously evolved to meet the changing needs and goals of industrial growth in Chhattisgarh.

The new policy introduces several incentives to promote industrial investments in the state. These incentives include interest subsidies, state capital investment subsidies (including infrastructure subsidies), stamp duty exemptions, electricity duty exemptions, entry tax exemptions, value-added tax (VAT) reimbursement, mandi fee exemptions, and project cost subsidies, among others. The policy is designed to not only boost industrial development but also to align with the nation-

al vision for a developed India by 2047, as envisioned by Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi. Chief Minister Shri Vishnu Deo Sai stated, "The policy was developed with a focus on employment generation and the goal of creating a developed Chhattisgarh in line with the vision for a developed India by 2047. The state's strategic central location, combined with modern transportation infrastructure and active participation from stakeholders, will help transform Chhattisgarh into a 'Health Hub' in the coming years. Besides, the state is set to begin the construction of an industrial zone on 118 acres of land near Jagdipur. Government is keen to attract more industries to the state. For the first time, the policy encourages investments in tourism and healthcare. The state government has recently granted the status of 'Industry' to the tourism sector, recognizing its significant potential for growth. This focus on emerging sectors is part of the state's effort to position itself as a key player in the future economy. One of the policy's standout features is the support for service industries, a growing

sector in India. For the first time, the policy offers special incentives for MSME service enterprises and large-scale service enterprises. This includes areas such as engineering services, research and development, healthcare, tourism, and entertainment. A Special Focus on Marginalized Groups Chhattisgarh is likely the individuals, weaker sections, and third-generation entrepreneurs, ensuring that these groups receive targeted support for economic upliftment and entrepreneurship. The policy ensures minimal government intervention in the establishment and operation of industries. To reduce bureaucratic hurdles, the state aims to promote self-certification and online procedures for industry-related processes, eliminating the need for businesses to interact directly with government offices unless

necessary. Chhattisgarh has also revised the definition of micro, small, and medium enterprises (MSMEs) in line with the central government's definition to make incentives more competitive compared to other states.

**Investment and Development A Bright Future Ahead**

The state's new industrial policy has already attracted significant attention from industrial giants. On September 4, 2024, during a Stakeholder Connect Workshop in Maya Rajpur, the state government issued "Intent to Invest" letters worth Rs 32,225 crore for investments in key sectors such as IT, AI, data centers, ethanol, electronics, compressed bio-gas, and more. Major industrial groups, including Shivalik Engineering, Maa Durga Iron and Steel, ABREL Green Energy, RAG Ferro Alloys, Reliance Big Energy, Yash Fans and Appliances, Shanti Greens Biofuel, Racle-Bank Datacenter and others, are poised to contribute to this economic transformation. To further strengthen these efforts, the state has classified its development blocks into three categories to ensure targeted incentives. Group 1 comprises 10 blocks, Group 2 includes 61 blocks, and Group 3 consists of 75 blocks, each with different levels of investment and incentives. Along with this, there are provisions for additional incentives for trust sector industries where the state has a competitive advantage and where future employment opportunities are expected. With a clear focus on the future, the Chhattisgarh government's New Industrial Policy is set to propel the state towards a brighter, more prosperous future, creating a thriving economy and ample job opportunities for its people.

**Over 5 lakh jobs in next five years**

New industrial policy envisions the creation of over 5 lakh jobs in the next five years. Chhattisgarh is on track to become one of the fastest-growing economies of the coming decade in sectors such as textiles, pharmaceuticals, AI, defence, energy, and medical tourism. The government's goal is to ensure the complete elimination of the Naxal issue by March 2026, paving the way for peace, stability, and new beginnings in all affected regions.
