We have reviewed the unaudited standalone financial results of Clean Science and Technology Limited (the "Company") for the quarter ended December 31, 2025 and the year to date results for the period April 01, 2025 to December 31, 2025, which are included in the accompanying 'Statement of Unaudited Standalone Financial Results for the quarter and nine months ended December 31, 2025' (the "Statement"). The Statement has been prepared by the Company pursuant to Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended (the "Listing Regulations, 2015"), which has been initialled by us for identification purposes.




- The Statement has been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in Indian Accounting Standard 34 "Interim Financial Reporting" ("Ind AS 34") prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules, 2015 as amended from time to time and the provisions of the Companies Act 2013 and other accounting principles.
- The Board of Directors in their meeting held on January 31, 2026, declared an Interim dividend of ₹ 2/- per share for the financial year 2025-26. The record date for the same is February 06, 2026. In accordance with Ind AS -10 'Event after reporting date' as notified by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs through Amendment to Companies (Accounting Standards) Amendment Rules, 2016 dated March 30, 2016, the Company has not accounted for interim dividend as a liability as at December 31, 2025.
- The above results have been subjected to Limited Review by the statutory auditors of the Company in terms of Regulation 33 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended and have been reviewed by the Audit Committee and thereafter approved and taken on record by the Board of Directors at its meeting held on January 31, 2026.
- As per Ind AS 108 'Operating Segments', when financial results contains both consolidated and standalone financial results for the parents, segment information needs to be presented only in case of consolidated financial results. Accordingly segment information has been provided only in consolidated financial results.
- During the nine months ended December 31, 2025, 9,240 equity shares of ₹ 1/- each fully paid-up, were allotted upon exercise of the vested stock options pursuant to the Company's Employee Stock Option Scheme, 2021 (ESOP 2021).
- Pursuant to the notification by the Ministry of Labour & Employment on November 21, 2025 on the Code on Wages, 2019, the Industrial Relations Code, 2020, the Code on Social Security, 2020 and the Occupational Safety, Health and Working Conditions Code, 2020 (collectively referred to as "the Labour Codes"), the Company has calculated the past service cost on gratuity payable to employees to be ₹ 2:50 million and has recognized the provision in the Statement of Unaudited Standalone Financial Results.
