**Briefs****'UN at risk of fin collapse'**

The UN is at risk of "imminent financial collapse" due to member states not paying their fees, the body's head has warned. António Guterres said the UN faced a financial crisis which was "deepening, threatening programme delivery", and that money could run out by July. He wrote a letter to ambassadors that all 193 member states had to honour mandatory payments or fundamentally overhaul the organisation's financial rules to avoid collapse.

**Ex-CNN host arrested**

Former CNN host Don Lemon has been arrested after he entered a Minnesota church and filmed anti-immigration enforcement protesters as they disrupted a service. Lemon, an independent journalist, was taken into custody by federal agents on Thursday night while in Los Angeles covering the Grammy Awards.

**UN: 170 die in Myanmar**

At least 170 people were killed in military air strikes during Myanmar's weeks' long election period, the UN has said. "Credible sources" had counted the civilian deaths, the UN rights office said, as well as 408 military aerial attacks from December 2025 to late last week, when the third and final round of voting was held. Union and Solidarity Party, backed by Myanmar's military, won.

**Kurd force, Syria ink deal**

The Kurdish-led Syrian Democratic Forces announced a new agreement on Friday with the country's central government intended to stabilise a ceasefire that ended weeks of fighting and to lay out the steps towards integration between the two sides.

**Indian human smuggler**

A 22-year-old citizen of India has been indicted in New York for his role in a scheme to smuggle Indian nationals from Canada across the northern border into the U.S. Shivam, whose last name is unknown, is charged with one count of conspiracy to illegally bring aliens to the U.S. and 4 counts of illegally bringing aliens to the U.S.

**Burkina Faso 'bans' parties**

Burkina Faso's military junta has dissolved all the political parties and scrapped the laws governing them, as per a decree approved by the govt. The dissolution of parties and similar groups follows measures activists say have targeted civic freedom and the opposition.

**At Trump's request, Russia not to hit Ukraine power grid**

**Moscow** Russia has agreed to a request from US President Trump to halt air strikes on Kyiv until February 1 amid harsh winter temperatures. Zelensky said it was ready to re-engage as Washington pushes for a diplomatic solution to the war.

But as the Ukrainian capital braces for another bitterly cold spell from Sunday, President Volodymyr Zelensky said there was no formal truce between the nations. Russia had shifted to hitting Ukrainian logistics. Russia has bombed Ukraine's roads and railways in recent days.

Zelensky said there were no attacks on Ukrainian energy facilities overnight, and Moscow's focus had shifted towards strikes on logistics infrastructure. The Kremlin said President Vladimir Putin had accepted Trump's request to stop bombing Kyiv to create "favourable conditions" for peace talks.

**US to Iran: End N-plan, stop killing protesters****Agencies**

US President Donald Trump has warned Iran it must end its nuclear programme and stop killing protesters if the large US armada of warships deployed in West Asia are not to be used, "The Guardian" reported. The Republican leader said protesters were being killed in thousands, but he had stopped Iran from carrying out executions.

**ARAGHCHI IN TURKEY TO MEET ERDOGAN**

Iranian Foreign Minister Abbas Araghchi landed in Turkey to discuss whether there was a basis for a deal with the US. He was due to meet President Recep Tayyip Erdogan but in his initial remarks Araghchi gave little sign of a breakthrough.

Trump told reporters he had been speaking to the Iranians and intended to do so more, but it was not clear whether he simply meant he was speaking to the Iranian government through intermediaries.

With his precise objectives in Iran sometimes unclear, Trump told reporters Iran had to do "two things" to avoid military action. "Number one, no nuclear. And number two, stop killing protesters," the US president said, adding, "they are killing them by the thousands." He added: "We have a lot of very big, very powerful ships sailing to Iran right now, and it would be great if we didn't have to use them."

**US PILING MORE DEMANDS: TEHRAN**
